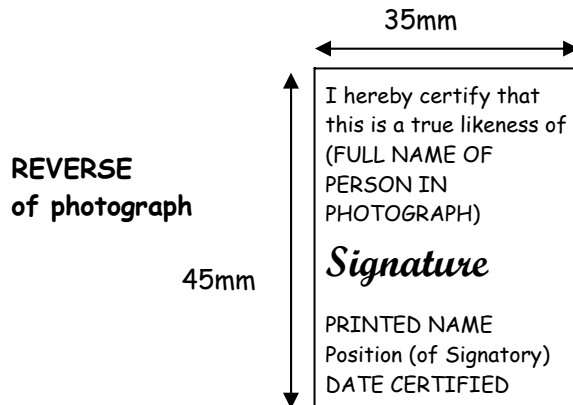


GUIDE TO PHOTOGRAPHS FOR PERSONAL LICENCE APPLICATIONS

What is being certified?

On signing one of your two photographs, the counter-signatory is declaring that the photograph is a true likeness of yourself.

Below is an example of a correctly signed photograph.



Who can countersign my photographs for application?

- THE COUNTER-SIGNATORY MUST HOLD A PROFESSIONAL QUALIFICATION.
- THE COUNTER-SIGNATORY MAY NOT BE A SPOUSE OR RELATIVE.
- PERSONAL LICENCE HOLDERS MAY NOT CERTIFY PHOTOS.

Articled Clerk of a Limited Company	Member of Parliament
Assurance Agent of Recognised Company	Merchant Navy Officer
Bank/Building Society Official	Minister of a recognised religion
Barrister	Nurse (SRN and SEN)
Broker	Officer of the armed services (Active or Retired)
Chairman/Director of Limited Company	Optician
Chemist	Person with Honours (eg OBE MBE etc)
Chiropodist	Police Officer
Christian Science Practitioner	Post Office Official
Commissioner of Oaths	President/Secretary of a recognised organisation
Councillor: Local or County	Salvation Army Officer
Civil Servant (permanent)	Social Worker
Dentist	Solicitor
Engineer (with professional Qualifications)	Surveyor
Fire Service Official	Teacher, Lecturer
Funeral Director	Trade Union Officer
Insurance agent (full time) of a recognised Company	Valuers and auctioneers (fellow and associate members of the incorporated society)
Justice of the Peace	Warrant officers and Chief Petty Officers
Legal Secretary (members and fellows of the Institute of legal secretaries)	

Or persons of similar standing to the above, working or retired, are acceptable as counter-signatories.
